Hangzhou comprises 8 municipal districts and 3 county-level cities and 2 counties. The City Hall is located in Gongshu District.



The main peak here is 266 meters above sea level. Climbing to the top and overlooking the northwest region, you can have a panoramic view of more than 90 islands, like a string of pearls scattered along the lake. Looking into the southwest, you can see the vast expanse of the great lake with Laoshan Island hidden in the mist.

The Stone Forest Scenic Spot in Qiandao Lake is one of China's four major stone forests. Its wide coverage, large scale, and unique landscape are unique in East China, and it is known as "The First Stone Forest of East China."

The Orient Culture Park is built in accordance with the layout of the Eight Trigrams of Zhou Yi (*The Book of Changes*) and with the perfect infusion of Confucian, Buddhist and Taoist building styles.
