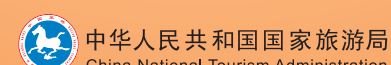

Wuhan Overview

Wuhan has a long history and has been a military and commercial city in south China ever since the Spring and Autumn and Warring States periods. The city is divided into Wuchang, Hankou and Hanyang by the Yangtze River, forming three distinct towns standing around the river.

Wuhan's climate features abundant rainfall, sufficient sunshine, hot summers and cold winters.

It is a major city with the most abundant water resources in the world. The Yangtze River and the Hanjiang River meet there. In addition, Wuhan also has 166 lakes, so it is

East Lake

The East Lake, China's largest city lake, is the largest tourist attraction in Wuhan City. The lakeshore twists and turns and branching streams wind across the region, also known as the "99" bends.

Listening-to-the-Waves Scenic Area

This place is a long narrow peninsula. The island's structures include the Moon Pavilion (Xianyueting), Bamboo Porch (Kezhuxuan), open air theatre, Listening-to-the-Waves Tower (Tingtaoxuan), Poetry-Reciting Pavilion (Xingyinge), Lake Gallery and Qu Yuan Memorial Hall, among others.



East Lake

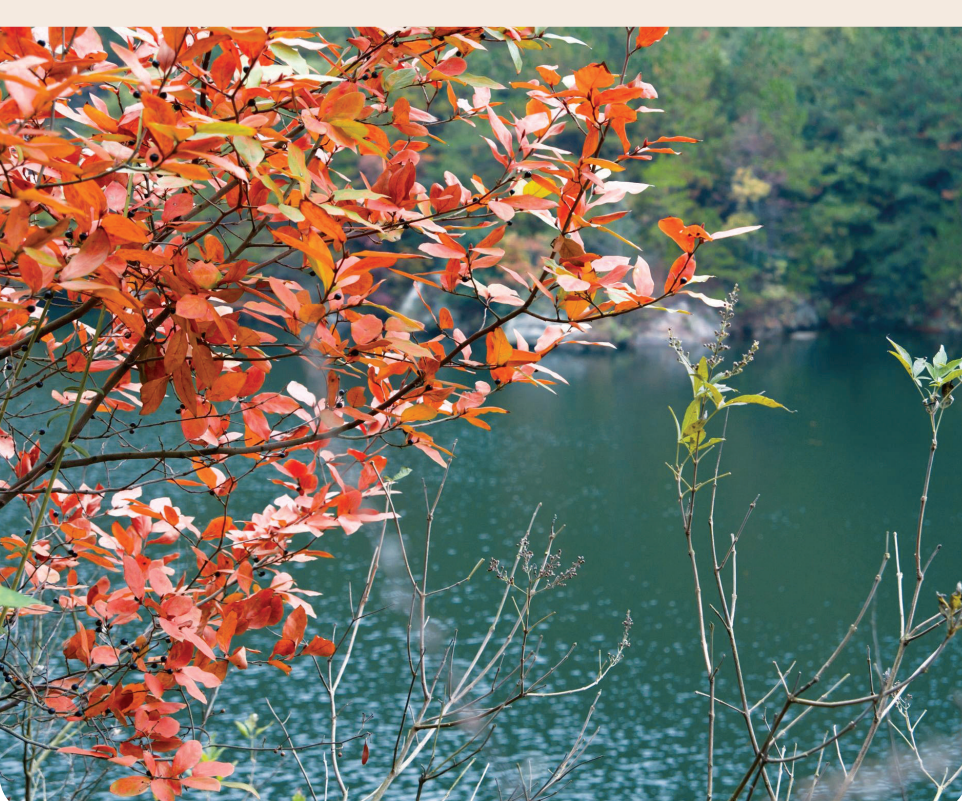

Mulan Mountain

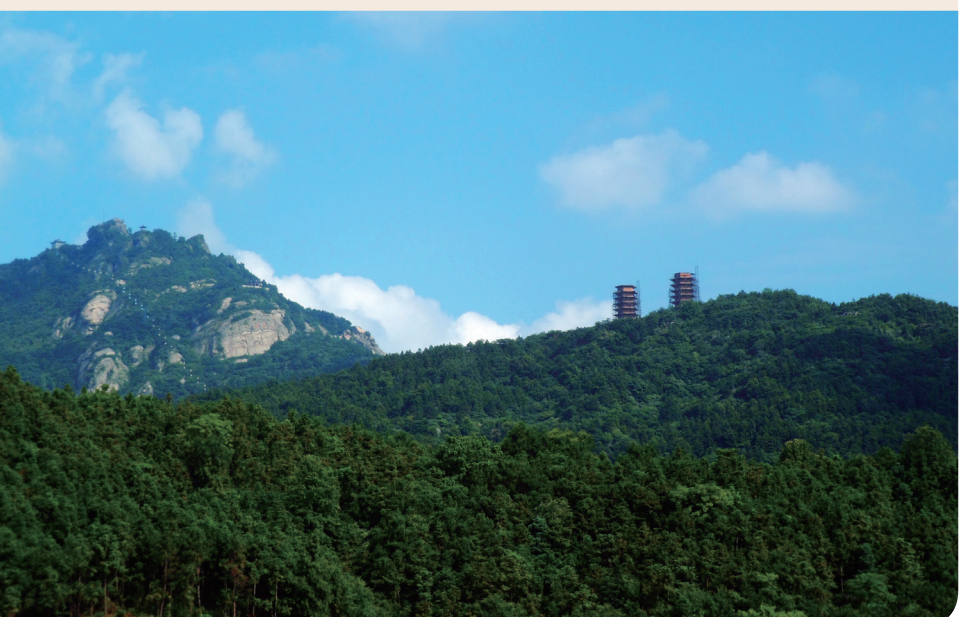
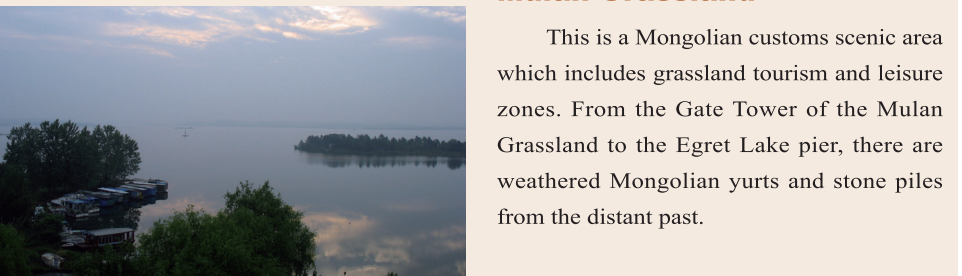

Mulan Mountain

Yellow Crane Tower

The Yellow Crane Tower is one of the "four most famous towers in ancient China," also known as "No. 1 Tower under Heaven." Standing on the tower looking into the distance, you can see the endless Yangtze River and the scenery of three towns.

Historic Sites

Heptacord Terrace (Guqin Tai)
Guqin Tai is built to honor Yu Boya and Zhong Ziqi's sincere friendship, and known as a "Terrace of Friendship." Main attractions include the "Wu Museum" of the story of Yu Boya and Zhong Ziqi, and the White Marble Statue of "Boya Playing the Zither."

Qingchuan Pavilion
First established in the Jiaqing Period of the Ming Dynasty, Qingchuan Pavilion mainly consists of Qingchuan Tower, Yuji Palace, the Iron Gate Pass's three main buildings and other auxiliary building clusters.



Historical(Historical) Sites

Wuhan Yangtze River Bridge
The Wuhan Yangtze River Bridge is the first bridge built over the Yangtze River in China, and is known as "the first bridge of the Yangtze River." It is a double layer steel truss girder bridge with highway and railway function. Its structure allows gigantic ships to pass through.

Gude Temple
Unlike the yellow tiles, red columns, overhanging eaves and rake angles of the traditional temple architectural style, Gude Temple combines many different features of



Urban Leisure

Wuhan Botanical Garden of CAS
Attractions at the Wuhan Botanical Garden include the Landscape Greenhouse, Flower Square, Shuiyunjian Scenery, Rock Plant Garden, and artificial "Underwater Forest." There are 7,500 species of plants and more than 1,600 species of greenhouse plants, including more than 1,200 species of tropical rainforest, papyrus plants and more than 400 species of orchids.

Hankou Beach Park
Hankou Beach Park stretches for 7,000 meters with precious trees and fragrant grass, and highlights the ecological, leisure features of the region. There are many sculptures in the square of the park showing the history of Wuhan.



Universities and Museums

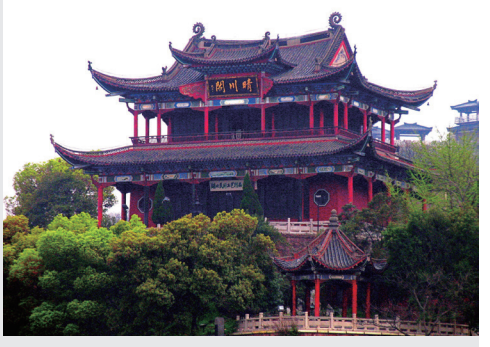
Wuhan University
Wuhan University, known as one of the "most beautiful college campuses in the world," sits on the Luojia Hill, surrounded by the East Lake. The campus has palace-style buildings combining Western and Chinese elements, simple and elegant, lofty and magnificent. The cherry blossoms on the campus are well known throughout the city.

Hubei Provincial Museum
The entire architecture of the Hubei Provincial Museum highlights Chu-style architectural features of multilayer and wide eaves and macro slope roofs. The museum boasts an extensive and varied collection, with more than 200,000 cultural relics.

By Air
Wuhan's first airline was opened in 1929. Wuhan Tianhe International Airport, officially opened on April 15, 1995, is the first 4F class airport in central China. It has 76 regular airlines with direct flights to Paris, Tokyo, San Francisco, Osaka, Seoul, Singapore, Bangkok, Ho Chi Minh City and other 20 international cities.

By Train

Wuhan's public transportation system is very convenient. It has nearly 300 public bus routes. In addition, the city now has Metro



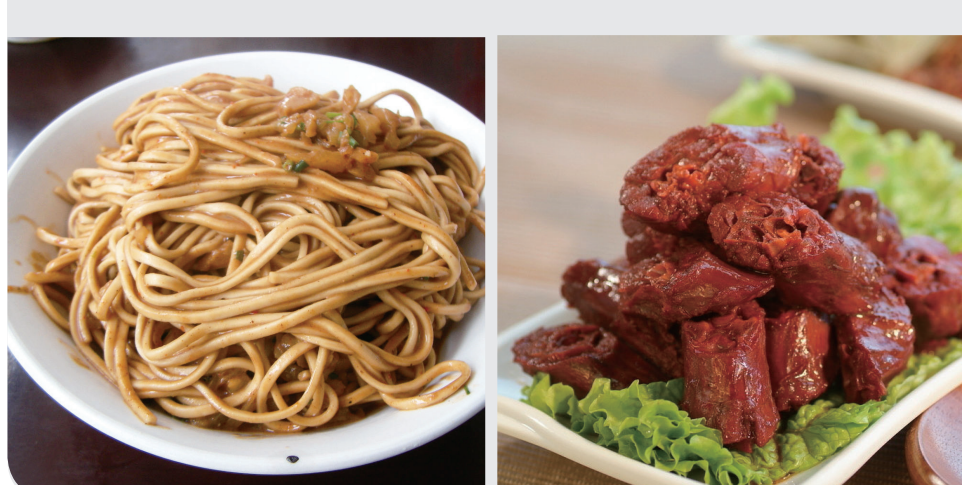
Dining

Hubei cuisine is a combination of four local styles, Wuhan, Jingsha, Huangzhou and Xiangyun, and is typically represented by Wuhan cuisine. Famous main dishes such as steamed Wuchang fish, Three Steamed Dishes in Tianmen, braised Yihe river clam, Duck neck, hot dry noodles and lotus root pork rib soup are popular.

Deep Fried Lotus Root Sandwich
Hubei Province abounds in lotus root, whether it is in a salad, fried, steamed, stewed, stir fried, deep fried or roasted. Deep fried lotus root sandwich is always a must-have dish on holidays or wedding banquets.

Steamed Wuchang Fish
The main ingredient of this dish is about 1 kg of freshwater fish, accompanied by ham, mushrooms, bamboo shoots, chicken soup and more than 10 other kinds of ingredients and spices. The steamed fish is bright in color and fragrant in smell. It is tender and smooth and the soup fresh and delicious.

Hubu Lane
As the most famous "one-stop breakfast lane" in Wuhan, Hubu Lane is a 150-meter long lane with over a century of history. Its bustling breakfast stalls have operated continuously for 20 years.



Shopping

Steamed Wuchang fish is at the top of the list of Wuchang specialties. Other specialties include Makou ceramics, Honghu lotus root, Honghu feather fan, Jiangling antique lacquer wares, Hongshan purple pakchoi, sweet-scented osmanthus crispy candy, special Yellow Crane Tower wine and so on. Characteristic shopping centers are seen in Jianghan Pedestrian Street, Hanzheng Street small commodity markets and Simenkou Pedestrian Street.

Jianghan Pedestrian Street
It is the longest pedestrian street in China known as "the first pedestrian street under Heaven." The street is 1,600 meters long and 10 to 25 meters wide. It is a famous century-old commercial street in Wuhan as well as the "Wuhan Architecture Museum of the 20th Century."



Entertainment

Yangtze River Crossing
The river crossing activity starts from Hanyang Gate and goes all the way to the Three Gorges Stone Square (Sanxiashi Square) of Hankou Beach. The straight-line distance of this crossing is 4,295 meters and it is the line once crossed by Mao Zedong.

Wuhan Han Opera
Han Opera, commonly known as "erhuang," is the leading opera in Hubei. There are more than 600 traditional theatrical pieces of Han Opera, most of which are historical stories and folklores.
